Fall 1998 *Patterns:* Russian tape lace collar; Lia's Snowman. *Technique:* Needle-lace how-to; article regarding thread charts, 'which thread' to use.

Winter 1998 *Patterns:* Lia's Santa head; a trio of old prickings (Torchon or Cluny). *Technique:* What is Floral Torchon?

Spring 1999 *Patterns:* New Pitsligo lace; old Beds. pricking, mystery pricking; Buckspoint bookmark. *Technique:* managing gimps in Bucks, and ending a bookmark at a point (no tassel). Roller pillow with locking mechanism.

Fall 1999 *Patterns:* Buckspoint paperweight; Weeping Willow free lace/Torchon; old pricking to interpret. *Technique:* One-handed Buckspoint lace; tatted medallion 'corner.'

Winter 1999 *Patterns:* Romanian Point Lace how-to, and bridge coasters; window panel, Torchon; new design Beds. bookmark; Torchon edging in linen

Spring 2000 *Patterns:* Romanian Point Lace butterfly; Buckspoint bookmark, two acorns; tape lace collar; contemporary Beds. bookmark. *Technique:* build an ethafoam pillow; more RPL how-to.

Summer 2000 *Patterns:* small edging in Mechlin; Buckspoint insertion; fleurs-de-lis in Russian tape lace; swirl motif in Schneeberger; coaster and bookmark from old pricking (from Fall 99). *Technique:* Lace and cross-stitch samplers; Mechlin how-to.

Volume 15

Fall 2000 *Patterns:* Torchon edging to interpret; square start Torchon bookmark; pointed start Torchon bookmark; Whale in Torchon, 'cuff' for Christmas socks in plaits and leaves; Buckspoint hexagon mat; mat in Beds/Cluny; Honiton clover. *Technique:* 'another way to make leaves.'

Winter 2000 *Patterns:* Lia's Christmas star; corner pattern, Le Puy; Holly ornament in CTC and plaits; Honiton ivy pricking; Plaited star in a ring of CT and double CT; Beds. Leaf motif; small Tatted 3D Butterfly; single repeat for Buckspoint edging; letter 'C' in plaits and CTC. *Technique:* Branscombe Point tape lace.

Spring 2001 *Patterns:* Honiton butterfly pricking; Milanese butterfly sampler; small Buckspoint flower motif; large tatted 3D butterfly; mystery pricking; daffodil in creative Torchon. *Technique:* Branscombe, part two; intro to Withof Duchesse.

Summer 2001 *Patterns:* Flanders fleur-de-lis; Buckspoint edging; Coventry thistle edging (Malmesbury); Torchon mat; mystery pricking re-interpreted; Roseground bookmark with leaves. *Technique:* using colours in lace.

Volume 16

Fall 2001 *Patterns*: Chantilly edging; Torchon cross; dentate leaf in Honiton; Roseground edging; Christmas tree motifs in tape lace and creative Torchon; Russian tape lace 'pumpkin'. *Technique*: Buckspoint (antique lace).

Winter 2001 *Patterns*: Star over Bethlehem in Russian tape. Torchon heart motif; 'Big Pig's Nose' edging in freehand lace; New Zealand foliage motif in creative Torchon; wrapped thread ornament. *Technique*: 'what if' – lace design

Spring 2002 *Patterns*: Hearts and Scallops Torchon edging; Beds. cravat end; hanky edging, creative Torchon; three ornaments in plaits, leaves and CTC; butterfly motifs for Carrickmacross. *Technique*: mending a crochet tablecloth.

Summer 2002 *Patterns*: Torchon scarf in merino wool; pillow for the scarf; simple motif in Chrysanthemum lace; *Technique*: folding a lace-edged hanky; lace design from pictures; '7-pair crossing'

Volume 17

Fall 2002 *Patterns*: lace knit washcloths; mat with fans and CT/CTC for a pincushion top; wool blanket cookie pillow; mat on logarithmic grid; Christmas ornaments – drum or serviette ring, ball in creative Torchon *Technique*: Half-stitch sampler.

Winter 2002 *Patterns*: four Christmas ornament patterns to interpret; Fir-tree fan and hearts corner and edging; Torchon star for coloured threads; CTC Star with Milanese spider; 'pricking' from a crochet doily. *Technique*: beadmaking lesson.

Spring 2003 *Patterns*: Torchon edging with Russian ground (roseground); wreath and robbin motif in Blonde lace; small heart motif with beads; contemporary Beds. star. *Technique*: Needlelace, halas and contemporary.

Summer 2003 *Patterns*: Quick Torchon garter; lace covers in plaits and leaves for Easter eggs; *Technique*: Ret-Fi.

Fall 2003 *Patterns*: Two Torchon bookmarks: Fans with keyhole, Fanciful Flower; round mat, Beds.; creative lace with 3 pairs *Technique*: 'Punto Fiandra'

Winter 2003 *Patterns*: mystery pricking; Torchon bookmark with spiders, CTC diamonds and hearts; 'Peace' bookmark; trim in Torchon lace; 'snowflake' mat with hearts (Buckspoint style). *Technique*: creative lace – Christmas lights with half-stitch variation; decorative bands with regular ground.
